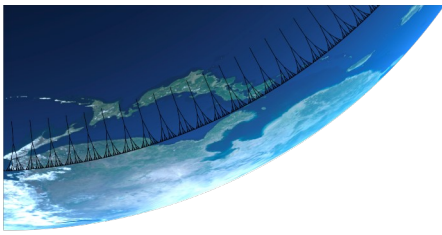

In consideration of these premises and of the mutual promises and covenants herein, The Parties hereby agree as follows:

2) Defined Terms:

- a) “Contest” shall mean: The Project Atlantis Animation Contest subject to the [Contest Rules](#).
- b) “Start Date” shall mean: The date on which The Atlantis Project starts accepting submissions.
- c) “Submission Deadline” shall mean: The date on which The Atlantis Project stops accepting Submissions.
- d) “Submitted Video” shall mean: Files(s) provided to The Atlantis Project with the following name(s):
- e) “Effective Date” shall mean: Date of the last signature below.
- f) “Winning Video” shall mean: Portions of a Submitted Video that are awarded first or second place by Contest judges appointed by The Atlantis Project.
- g) “Winning Video Announcement Date” shall mean: The date that The Atlantis Project announces the Winning Video.

3) By checking “Yes” below, the Contestant agrees to allow their Submission, or portions of their Submission to be used anonymously for the purpose of educating animators on how to avoid making mistakes when animating content related to the tethered ring.
(Replying Yes or No has no bearing on your eligibility to enter the contest.)

4) Artist Credits:

The Contestant agrees to be credited for their work under the following name:

The Atlantis Project reserves the right, at its own discretion, to use the Contestant’s provided legal name, if it feels that the name the Contestant provides in the field above is inappropriate.

If the site does not contain content that some might find offensive, and if some of the Contestant’s Submission earns a first-place prize, then this link will be included in the description when The Atlantis Project uses the Contestant’s Winning Video(s).

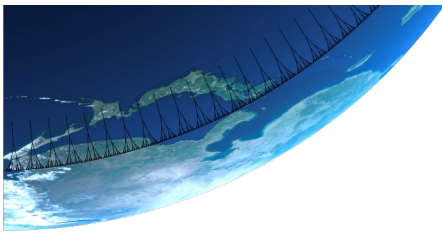
5) License

The Contestant hereby grants The Atlantis Project non-exclusive rights to the Winning Video(s) from the Submitted Video(s).

6) Consideration:

The Atlantis Project shall inform the Contestant by email within ten days of the Winning Video Announcement Date if a portion or portions of the Contestant’s Submitted Video have become a Winning Video, how many seconds of video have placed first or second in the Contest, and the amount that shall be awarded.

The amount shall be \$50.00usd per second (first place) and \$20.00usd per second (second place) of Winning Video.

The Contestant will submit an expense to [The Atlantis Project Collective](#) for the amount specified in the email within 30 days of the Winning Video Announcement Date.

If the Contestant submits an expense for the correct amount within 30 days of the Winning Video Announcement Date, The Atlantis Project shall approve the expense from the Contestant within 60 days of the Winning Video Announcement Date.

7) International activity that we can't enable:

- a) Anything against the regulations OFAC operates under as a US 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization;
- b) Activity involving a country or region embargoed or sanctioned by the US government;
- c) Activity involving individuals or entities included on the OFAC List of Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons;
- d) Payments to a country not served by our standard payment processors;
- e) Violations of our policies that we apply to all activities;
- f) Employing people outside of the US (however, we may be able to engage them as contractors if other criteria are met);
- g) Making grants or in-kind contributions to a non-US individual or organization, or "Model C"-type grantee-grantee fiscal sponsorship, except in approved exceptional cases of international humanitarian aid; and
- h) Initiatives focused on an international location/cause that are wholly led by American residents without demonstrated connections to that place or local project co-leaders.
